High-strength flanged step-rail connections and a metal hinge connection with rail-surrounding hinge protection ensure high stability. The screwed-on metal storage tray, on which tools and materials are always within reach, also pays off in everyday work. Large foot caps with soft inserts improve slip resistance and protect the floor thanks to a softer, wider standing surface – a solid basis for many projects around the house.
